JROTC EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

1. PURPOSE

This policy letter establishes guidelines for the following extracurricular activities of the Dinwiddie High School Army JROTC Dept:

- b. Drill Team
- c. Rifle Team

3. RESPONSIBILITIES

a. JROTC Departments are required to maintain at least one color guard team. Development and maintenance of all other teams are highly recommended.

b. The SAI is responsible to ensure that all cadets who participate in competitive events meet eligibility requirements for JROTC participation.

4. PROCEDURES

a. Participation on each team will be voluntary. Members of each team are required to attend practice on the days prescribed by the instructors.

b. Each team will have a designated team captain and/or manager.

c. Cadets participating in co-curricular activities must have and maintain a minimum of a 2.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.

d. Cadets that have been suspended from school can not attend practice or any team event during that suspension timeframe.

e. Cadets will be supervised at all teams during practice or at a competition/meet by the SAI, AI or adult chaperone.

f. Cadets will receive one merit point for each hour of practice and five merit points for participation in a competition/meet.

g. Attendance will be taken at each practice and competition to ensure cadets are given the appropriate credit for participation.

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
