

Dinwiddie High School Army JROTC Promotion Criteria's

2-4 Promotion Policy:

For all promotions, the battalion table of organization and its rank structure will be used as a guide. In no case will it be exceeded without the approval of the Senior Army Instructor. Cadets are eligible for promotion during each of the first and second semester of the current school year. All promotion recommendation rosters are due to the Battalion Adjutant (S-1) two weeks prior to the end of the promotion period.

A. Enlisted Promotion: To be eligible for promotion to the rank of C/PVT (E-2), cadets must meet the following criteria:

1. Receive a passing grade in all academic classes.
2. Be recommended for promotion by SAI/ AI or their Company Commander/ First sergeant.
3. Missed less than two uniform/PT days during the nine weeks.
4. Recite the JROTC Creed

B. Enlisted Promotion: To be eligible for promotion to the rank of C/PFC (E-3), cadets must meet the following criteria:

1. Received a passing grade in all academic classes.
2. Have the rank of C/PVT (E-2).
3. Be recommended for promotion by SAI/ AI or their Company Commander/ First sergeant.
4. Missed less than two uniform/PT days during the nine weeks.
5. Recite the JROTC Creed

C. Noncommissioned Officer: To be eligible for promotion to C/CPL (E-4), cadets must meet the following criteria:

1. Receive a passing grade in all academic classes.
2. Be assigned to a C/PFC position.
3. Missed no more than one uniform/PT days during the nine weeks.
4. Must score an 80% or higher on a Basic Knowledge Test.
5. Be recommended for a promotion by SAI/AI or their Company Commander/ First sergeant.
6. Demonstrate the ability to conduct squad drill prior to being promoted.

D. Noncommissioned Officer: To be eligible for promotion to the rank of C/SGT (E-5), cadets must meet the following criteria:

1. Receive a passing grade in all academic classes with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
2. Receive a written recommendation from Platoon Leader/ Sergeant.
3. Have the rank of C/CPL.
4. Demonstrate the ability to conduct platoon drill prior to being promoted.
5. Missed no more than one uniform/PT days during the nine weeks.
6. Must pass the promotion board and know the JROTC Chain-of-command .

E. Noncommissioned Officer: To be eligible for promotion to C/SSG (E-6), cadets must meet the following criteria:

1. Receive a passing grade in all academic classes with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
2. Be assigned to a C/SGT.
3. Missed no more than one uniform/PT days during the nine weeks.
4. Demonstrate the ability to conduct unarmed platoon and squad drill prior to being promoted.
5. Must pass the promotion board and know the JROTC Chain-of-command.
6. Be recommended for a promotion by their Company Commander/First sergeant.
7. Demonstrate the ability to conduct Physical Training prior to being promoted.

F. Noncommissioned Officer: To be eligible for promotion to C/SFC (E-7), cadets must meet the following criteria:

1. Receive a passing grade in all academic classes with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
2. Be assigned to a C/SSG.
3. Missed zero uniform/PT days during the nine weeks.
4. Received a written recommendation from the Command Sergeant Major.
5. Demonstrate the ability to conduct armed and unarmed platoon and squad drill prior to being promoted.
6. Demonstrate the ability to conduct physical training prior to being promoted.
7. Must be able to explain the duties and responsibilities of a squad leader and platoon sergeant.
8. Must pass the promotion board and know the JROTC Chain-of-command.

G. Noncommissioned Officer: To be eligible for promotion to C/MSG (E-8) cadets must meet the following criteria:

1. Receive a passing grade in all academic classes with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
2. Must be familiar with policy letters and SOP.
3. Demonstrate the ability to conduct armed and unarmed platoon and squad drill prior to being promoted.
4. Demonstrate the ability to conduct physical training prior to being promoted.
5. Demonstrate the ability to conduct physical training, uniform inspections, and know the JROTC chain of command.
6. Must pass the promotion board and know the JROTC Chain-of-command.
7. Missed zero uniform/PT days during the nine weeks.
8. Must be able to explain the duties and responsibilities of a Platoon Sergeants and First Sergeant.
9. Received a written recommendation from the Command Sergeant Major.

H. Officer: To be eligible for promotion to C/2LT (O-1), through C/1LT (O-2) cadets must meet the following criteria:

1. Receive a passing grade in all academic classes with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
2. Have a zero balance of demerits or better prior to promotion days.
3. Received a written recommendation from the Company Commander.
4. Must pass the promotion board and know the JROTC Chain-of-command.
5. Must know the responsibilities of a Platoon Leader and all staff positions.
6. Demonstrate the ability to conduct uniform inspections and know the JROTC chain of command.
7. Missed zero uniform/PT days during the nine weeks.

I. Officer: To be eligible for promotion to C/CPT (O-3), and C/MAJ (O-4) cadets must meet the following criteria:

1. Receive a passing grade in all academic classes with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
2. Have a zero balance of demerits or better prior to promotion days.
3. Must know Battalion operations proficiently.
4. Must be recommended for promotion by the SAI.
5. Must pass the promotion board and know the JROTC Chain-of-command.
5. Must know the duties and responsibilities of a Company Commander, Executive Officer, and all staff positions.
6. Demonstrate the ability to conduct uniform inspections and know the JROTC chain of command.
7. Missed zero uniform/PT days during the a nine weeks.

2-5 Special Promotions:

Graduating cadets may be promoted one rank higher two weeks prior to graduation. If the Battalion C/CSM is a senior he/she is eligible to be promoted to the rank of major. If the Battalion C/CSM is a junior; he/she is eligible for promotion to C/CPT at the end of the year. Such promotions will be kept to a minimum, and only outstanding cadets will be honored. Each First Sergeant can select one or two cadets for a special promotion. The cadet must be a LET 1 with a rank of Corporal or below. Failing grades, current demerits will make cadets ineligible for special promotions. Most important, the SAI/AI reserves the right to promote any cadet(s) at any given time.
